

Financial Aid Applications Information for Families Applying for Aid for 2024-2025

Thank you for your interest in The Roxbury Latin School for the 2024-2025 school year. In order to be considered for financial assistance, you must complete a Financial Aid Application by January 15, 2024, for prospective families and December 15, 2023 for current families. Award decisions will be sent on March 10, 2024, for prospective families and in January for current families.

The Roxbury Latin School uses the Clarity Financial Aid platform to assess a family's financial need. RL defines "need" as the difference between the cost of attendance and a family's contribution toward that cost. The need assessment is based upon income and family expense information including assets, liabilities, family size, cost of living, and the number of children in tuition charging schools. It is not necessary to upload your tax documentation manually. Your 2022 1040 and W-2 will automatically be transferred from the IRS when you complete the verification step.

If parents are divorced, separated, or never married, both parents are required to complete a Clarity Financial Aid Application. The analysis of both parents' (and new spouses, if any) ability to contribute will be considered by the Committee.

ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- A copy of all 2023 W-2 forms (if applicable) are due by February 1, 2024.
- If a material difference exists between 2022 and 2023 income information, you may be asked to submit a copy of your 2023 federal tax return.

The Clarity Application must be submitted by January 15, 2024, for prospective families and December 15, 2023, for current families.
